



**CALL FOR SCHOLARSHIPS SUPPORTING STUDENTS FROM
EXTRA EUROPEAN COUNTRIES, REGULARLY ENROLLED IN
THE FIRST YEAR OF THE MASTER DEGREES of the UNIVERSITY
OF INSUBRIA**

Item 1: Description and objectives

University of Insubria, offers scholarships to students coming from extra European and not OECD countries regularly enrolled in the first year of a master degree program during the academic year 2018-2019.

Item 2: Duration and economic conditions

The following opportunities are available:

- 10 scholarships amounting 4000 euro before taxes (and any other duty applicable according to Italian laws) and will last one academic year for applicants not having other benefits such as: other kind of scholarships, **in particular it is incompatible with the regional scholarship**, free accommodation in the University residences;
- 10 scholarships amounting 2000 euro before taxes (and any other duties applicable according to Italian laws) and will last one academic year for applicants having other benefits such as: other kind of scholarships, **in particular it is incompatible with the regional scholarship**, free accommodation in the University residences.

Beneficiary students must attend courses, take exams, and pass at least 30 ECTS credits by the end of the summer session of exams (30th September 2019); otherwise they will be required to return the whole amount of the scholarship.

The scholarships will be paid in two equal installments; the first one will be granted after the publication of the ranking list; the second one after the verification of the above mentioned requirements.

Item 3: Selection criteria and application

Applications will be evaluated on the basis of their previous records and qualifications (titles and academic career), bachelor degree grade, motivation and personal/professional background and, if needed through a personal interview with the candidates. The evaluation will be carried out by a Committee nominated by the Rector of the University of Insubria.





The ranking of the candidates, indicating the winners, will be published on the web site of the Ufficio Diritto allo Studio e Servizi agli Studenti and communicated to the applicants; should any of them renounce, the scholarship will be granted to the following student ranked on the list. After the publication of the results, students have to confirm the acceptance of the scholarship within 7 working days.

Applications must include:

- a cover letter
- the applicant's curriculum vitae with records of university career (transcript of records showing all the exams passed) and with professional experiences
- a motivation letter

The deadline for receiving the applications is **21st January 2019**.
